Speaking about lifestyle and unique experiences, keep an eye out for a special feature about San Lameer Estate that will be showcased on the DSTV KykNet Channel in the month of September. I know you will enjoy this special presentation. As we immerse ourselves in the tranquillity of this coastal paradise, I am reminded of the extraordinary journey that has led us to where we are today. San Lameer Estate has evolved into a place where architectural sensitivity and environmental sustainability merge seamlessly, creating a haven that transcends ordinary living.

The estate management team is hard at work on the alternative energy and water supply project for the Estate. The board is aware of the negative effect the unreliable supply of water and electricity is having – and continues to have – on property values and the general enjoyment of San Lameer. We undertake to investigate and find alternatives that will put San Lameer in the best possible position at reasonable cost.

A company has been appointed to conduct a feasibility study for alternative water supply (as a first phase) and alternative energy (as a second phase). We envisaged that it will be concluded by

31 July 2023. A special information meeting was also held with homeowners to provide more information on the two projects, dealing with progress to date, the anticipated success in the initiated studies, expected dates to complete the projects and to answer any questions that they might have. The process of drilling boreholes on the Estate for the proposed water treatment works has since started and the drilling plan involves sinking five new boreholes and testing the existing ones.

On behalf of the entire San Lameer Estate family, I extend my deepest gratitude to our residents, partners and supporters who have accompanied us on this extraordinary journey. It is your unwavering belief in our vision that propels us forward, and we remain committed to delivering excellence in everything we do.

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GARDENS AND GROUNDS

Countryline is very happy to report that our main objectives in the first quarter of our first-year contract were to establish our team and to focus on clearing the inorganic and organic litter, introducing indigenous flowering plants, and tackling AIS in target areas. This has made a huge impact on the overall aesthetics of the landscaping areas, and we hope that the residents are seeing an improvement in the gardens.

In the first few months of 2023, the Countryline team has taken on the challenge of removing and poisoning Chromolaena, guava, sword fern and other AIS species in specific areas to

ensure that the natural habitat of San Lameer is kept pristine.

Invasive alien plants are a major threat to biodiversity and have the potential to disrupt the delicate natural balance in San Lameer’s ecosystem.

Ensuring that the plant palette is diverse and indigenous is one of our main objectives. The nursery upgrades have enabled our team to propagate Barleria, Plumbago and Tecoma plant material to be planted in open spaces at villas and lots around the Estate. Planting indigenous plants produce food and provide a habitat for beneficial indigenous species adapted to the region.

The chipper has been working non-stop and enables us to limit our environmental footprint as well as provide mulch for the garden beds to retain water and recycle nutrients into the soil.

We thank you for the opportunity to continue to provide service to San Lameer Estate homeowners.

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Following Our Crowned Eagles

Our Estate boasts a wide variety of Fauna and Flora. Yet our resident pair of Crowned Eagles has always been a principal point of interest for residents and visitors alike. Raptors are generally the most fascinating of the various avian species and several aspects of our eagles have made them special. They have been nesting in the same tree on the Estate for more than 20 years, they are unfazed by human presence and mechanical noise, and they have successfully reared a number of off-spring to add to the declining population of this highly-threatened species. It is this act of procreation that provokes the greatest interest on our Estate. The most common question asked by residents and visitors alike is: "Tell me. Is there a chick in the nest?" That happens only once a year and in the wild, where food is not abundant, it happens only every TWO years. Although food is abundant on the Estate, we are extremely fortunate if we see an annual chick hatched and



successfully reared. Weather conditions, particularly sustained rain when the chick is in its first month, can be a major challenge to survival.

This year the eagles have been perplexing in their behaviour. They started refurbishing the nest in early February and we had every reason to expect the female to have laid her eggs by now. But that has not happened. The two birds are sporadically at the nest but have not settled down to the baby-making business. Fortunately I have detailed records of their behaviour as far back as 2011 and in searching through the records, I found an interesting parallel with their breeding pattern in 2013. That year they also refurbished the nest in the early months of the year but photographs of the female feeding a chick are dated September. Since incubation takes between 48 and 54 days before the chick emerges, it is not impossible that this year's breeding season could start in June. However, we don't know what



the fertility shelf-life of the adults is and they may just have reached the end of their capacity for producing another chick. We'll hold our breaths.

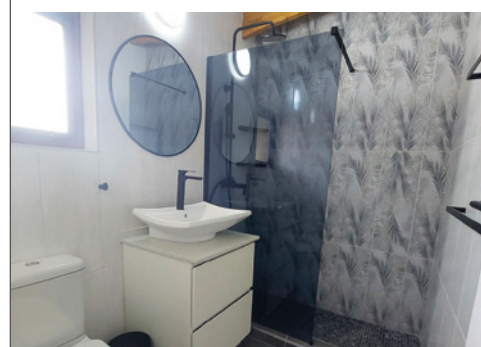
But let us look back exactly 10 years and see what the scene looked like in 2013. Five pictures show the male flying in with nesting material, the female about to launch herself to do the same thing, the two of them sitting in their refurbished nest in May and then the female feeding a one-month old chick at the end September 2013. That female chick ultimately took a mate in Umtentwini and has already produced two chicks herself.

But a walk around the Estate offers a wide variety of nature's treasures. The Bush Buck and the Impalas are in excellent condition. A fish eagle studies the Bird Hide dam for prey as a bee heads straight for it. Below, a Grey Heron patrols its waters searching for fish. On one of its perches the swallows were still there late in January but have now left to spend the summer in Europe. At several places on the Estate the seasonal white lilies present their splendour of green and white.

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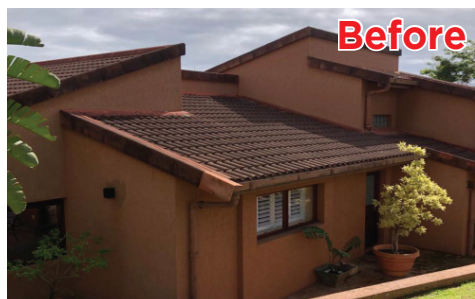

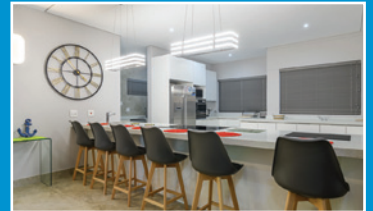

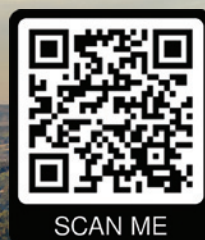

MOROCCAN *Lamb Shank*

SUBMITTED BY EXECUTIVE CHEF TALENT MTHEMBU FROM SAN LAMEER HOTEL



Melt-in-your-mouth Moroccan-styled braised lamb shanks will take you straight to the streets of Morocco in Northern Africa. Slightly sweet and succulent, you will fall in love with the aromatic flavours woven into each bite! Serve on Marrakesh-styled couscous.

INGREDIENTS

Lamb Shanks

- 1/4 cup extra virgin olive oil
- 4 meaty lamb shanks
- Salt and freshly ground black pepper
- 1 large onion, finely chopped
- 2 carrots, finely chopped
- 2 large garlic cloves, minced
- 1 tsp ground cumin
- 1/2 tsp ground coriander
- 1/2 tsp ground cinnamon
- 1/4 tsp ground allspice
- 1/4 tsp freshly grated nutmeg
- 2 tsp tomato paste
- 1 cup dry red wine
- 1 28-ounce can whole peeled tomatoes, drained and coarsely chopped
- 2 cups chicken stock or canned low-sodium broth
- 2 tbsp mint, finely chopped
- 2 tbsp coriander, chopped
- 2 tbsp unsalted butter
- 1 large shallot, minced

Couscous

- 150g instant couscous
- 1 cup water

METHOD

Lamb Shanks

1. Preheat the oven to 180°C.
2. In a large bain-marie casserole, heat two tablespoons of oil.
3. Season the shanks with salt and pepper.
4. Add the shanks to the casserole, two at a time, and cook over moderately high heat until browned all over, around 12 minutes.
5. Transfer to a plate and wipe out the casserole.
6. Heat the remaining two tablespoons of oil in the casserole.
7. Add the onion, carrots and garlic and cook over moderate heat, stirring for about five minutes until lightly browned.
8. Add the cumin, coriander, cinnamon, allspice and nutmeg and cook, stirring until lightly toasted, for about one minute.
9. Add the tomato paste and cook over moderately high heat, stirring until lightly browned, for about two minutes.
10. Stir in the wine and boil until reduced to a thick syrup, for about four minutes.
11. Add the tomatoes and one cup of the chicken stock to the casserole. Season with salt and pepper and bring to a boil.

12. Nestle the lamb shanks in the liquid.
13. Cover tightly and braise in the oven for about three hours, basting occasionally, until the meat is almost falling off the bone.
14. Transfer the shanks to a platter and cover with foil. Leave the oven on.
15. Strain the sauce into a bowl and skim any fat.
16. Return the sauce to the pot and boil over high heat until reduced to one cup, for about 10 minutes.
17. Return the vegetables and lamb to the sauce and keep warm.

Couscous

1. Melt the butter in a medium saucepan.
2. Add the onion and cook over moderately high heat until softened, for about two minutes.
3. Stir in the couscous and cook until lightly browned for two to three minutes.
4. Add the remaining one cup of chicken stock, water and 1/4 teaspoon of salt and bring to a boil.
5. Cover and let stand for 10 minutes.
6. Fluff with a fork and stir in with veggies

Serve and enjoy!



**TIP**

Toss the white chocolate in a little bit of flour before adding it to your mix. This will stop it from sticking to the bottom of the pan.

White Chocolate CHUNK BROWNIES

✓ PREP AND COOK TIME: 40 minutes

This recipe is pure decadence - enough said. However, life is all about balance - like balancing a salad in one hand and a brownie in the other. We're only joking!

INGREDIENTS

- 4 eggs
- 300g sugar
- 250g butter, melted
- 200g dark chocolate, melted
- 100g flour, sifted
- 25g cocoa powder
- 200g white chocolate, broken into small pieces

METHOD

1. Preheat the oven to 180°C and line a 20-centimetre square greased baking tin.
2. Beat the eggs and sugar in a bowl until very light and fluffy.
3. Slowly add the melted butter and melted dark chocolate.
4. Fold in the sifted flour and cocoa powder.
5. Stir in the white chocolate pieces.
6. Pour the batter into the greased baking tin and bake for 30 minutes.
7. Remove from the oven and allow to cool.
8. Slice and serve when ready.

THE ROLE OF A REAL ESTATE AGENT

Their core function is to play matchmaker between the homes on their stock list and the clients in their database. It takes years to build up a database of potential buyers that can be matched to a home, which is what makes a good real estate agent worth their weight in gold," he explains.

Unless sellers are prepared to face many hours dealing with interested parties and arranging appointments, enlisting the help of a real estate professional will also save them time. "An agent's role is also to screen potential buyers and ensure that the whole sales or rental process is handled efficiently."

Secondary to that, a good real estate professional will also act as a trusted advisor. "As experts within their local markets, they should be able to provide clients with valuable insights on market trends and housing prices in the area. They can also guide clients through the process of signing an OTP or lease agreement and will then put clients in touch with other experts who will help along the journey, such as bond originators, compliance certificate issuers, and transferring attorneys," he explains.

One of the most common misunderstandings arises when a defect is found on the property. "When defects are uncovered after a home is sold, it is important to understand that the responsibility does not fall on the real estate practitioner unless the seller told the agent and the agent did not disclose the information to the



buyer or purposefully hid the information from the buyer," says Goslett.

In closing, regardless of when you are selling, but especially in the current market, it is important to ensure you choose the right agent for your property. If you are not aware of the best agents in your area, ask for recommendations from neighbours or friends and ensure you follow their advice.

Always meet the agents in person before appointing them. This will give you a chance to ask questions and assess the agents. Check how long they have operated in the area and ask for a list of their recent sales, how long they took to sell and the prices achieved.

Choose someone with a successful sales track record and who will assist every step of the way. A strong sales record is an important indicator of the likelihood of success.

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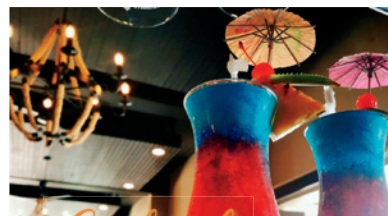
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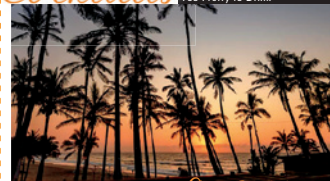
